



## GOLFSIXES LEAGUE FAQS

### *HOW DO I CHOOSE MY SQUAD?*

You can choose a squad of up to 12 players who will get to play in at least 4 fixtures each. All players should either have no handicap or 37 and above. It is preferable that the squad is mixed gender with exact ratios discussed at you league meeting.

### *HOW DO I KNOW WHAT COLOUR CAP MY SQUAD HAS BEEN ALLOCATED?*

Please ensure you have completed the club registration form and spoken with your league manager, so that the correct colour caps, player packs and team manager packs can be sent in plenty of time for your first fixture.

### *HOW DO I LAY OUT THE COURSE?*

Golfsixes League fixtures are played over 6 short holes. You can decide the length of these holes, but it is advised to be no longer than 150yds and avoid hazards that may be too tricky!

You can use the plastic tee markers provided in the league box to create temporary tees for your short holes.

Plan your loop of 6 using the most appropriate holes on your golf course

You may decide if time allows to play 9 holes with 6 “scoring” holes

### *ARE THERE ANY ADAPTED RULES TO USE WHEN PLAYING GOLFSIXES LEAGUE FIXTURES?*

Yes, there are a few!

- Air shots do not count, only when contact is made with the ball
- There is a 10 shot maximum on each hole. If a pair gets to 10 shots, they simply pick up the ball and mark that hole on the scorecard as a 10
- If a players ball lands in a bunker and the pair choose to play that ball, they both get 2 attempts to get hit the ball out of the bunker. If they are unsuccessful after 2 shots, they can pick up the ball and throw the ball towards the hole!

### *DO ALL 6 PLAYERS IN MY TEAM PLAY TOGETHER FOR A FIXTURE?*

For each fixture you will choose 6 players out of your squad of 12 (try and rotate the players so each get to play in at least 4 of the 8 fixtures)

You will need to organise your team into 3 pairs. Each of your pairs will play the 6 holes with a pair from another golf club

All players are playing against the course not directly against the other pair

Try and make sure that pairs playing with eachother for the fixture are of similar ages/ability



## *HOW DOES THE SCORING WORK?*

The scorecard provided gives you a simple point scoring system for each pair. Playing the Texas Scramble format each pair can score between 1-10 points per hole.

All 3 pairs are playing together as one team, the points across all 3 pairs and all 6 holes are added together to create a team score at the end of the fixture.

## *HOW DO I WORK OUT WHO WON THE FIXTURE?*

Each team score (made up of the 3 pairs scores) will be collected at the end of the fixture. The team with the most points will be the winning club for that fixture.

Depending on how many clubs are in your league, each club will then be allocated points, below is an example for a 4 club league;

- 1ST- 4 POINTS
- 2ND- 3 POINTS
- 3RD- 2 POINTS
- 4TH- 1 POINT

These fixtures and league points will be added to the Master Scorecard at the end of every fixture and sent through to your League Manager.

## *WHAT DO I NEED TO PREPARE IF I AM HOSTING A FIXTURE?*

- Ensure that you have the League Box in plenty of time before the first fixture
- Set up the 6 hole loop on your course
- Have someone to welcome the teams and give a briefing of any local information if required
- Arrange the pairings and shotgun start/tee times
- Provide some refreshments for players (if required)
- Make sure you have scorecards for every pair and a Master Scorecard to be completed once the fixture has finished

## *WHAT DO I NEED TO DO AFTER A FIXTURE?*

- Collect in all scorecards and complete Master scorecard
- League box to be given to the next hosting club
- Report back all scores to the League Organiser

## *WHERE CAN I SEE HOW WELL MY CLUB ARE DOING?*

There will be online leaderboards that you can access on the Golf Foundation website to see up to date leaderboards for your league. Your League Organiser will send you the link for this.
